Rapid City Kennel Club Training Class Descriptions

All Puppies MUST have certification of inoculations and dogs over 6 months must have ALL immunization shots.

Puppy Kindergarten (Puppies 2-6 months of age) - 6 weeks - \$53.00

This class will teach the commands "Sit", "Down", "Come", "Wait", "Leave it" and "Off", as well as teaching the dogs to walk on a loose leash, greet people and other dogs politely, and allow physical handling. We address housetraining, basic grooming, biting, chewing, digging, barking, jumping up, and problem solving. All your questions about dog behavior will be answered, and dogs will get some chances to socialize — one of the most important factors for a well-behaved, happy dog. This class sets the basis for good manners all the time, everywhere!

Beginning Obedience (For dogs 6+ months) - 8 weeks - \$74.20

Designed to assist with obedience concepts and training of the older dog (more than 6 months of age). Polish skills, provide socialization, and learn new handler techniques while focusing on teaching manners and self-control. A continuation of training for the dog and handler who have successfully completed Puppy Kindergarten.

Advanced Obedience (For dogs 6+ months & have completed Beginning Obedience) - 8 weeks - \$74.20

These classes prepare you and your dog to compete in AKC/UKC obedience trials. Dog and handler work as a team to earn titles by performing a series of obedience exercises. Each team is judged on accuracy, precision and enjoyment as they perform the exercises individually.

Canine Good Citizen Class (For dogs 6+ months) - 8 weeks - \$74.20

Many dog owners choose Canine Good Citizen training as the first step in training their dogs. The Canine Good Citizen Program lays the foundation for other AKC activities such as obedience, agility, tracking, and performance events. The CGC will be only a beginning for you and your dog and that after passing the CGC test, we hope you'll continue training in obedience, agility, tracking, or performance events.

Rally (Beg/Adv) - (For dogs 6+ months & have completed Beginning Obedience) - 6 weeks - \$53.00

Rally is the newest American Kennel Club (AKC) sport and provides an intermediate step between pet obedience and obedience competition. Promoting fun and teamwork, Rally consists of obedience exercises performed like agility on a numbered and timed course. Our class "Introduction to Rally" is a fun and positive way to build obedience skills and rapport with your dog. We will cover Rally exercises each week, run Rally courses, and further develop obedience skills including sit, stay, heeling, front, and finish.

Agility (Beg/Adv) - (For dogs 6+ months & have completed Beginning Obedience) - 6 weeks - \$53.00

At the end of this fun, active class, you will know why Dog Agility is one of the fastest growing sports in the USA. The sessions will be spent with you and your dog having fun together participating in an introduction to this exciting and rewarding activity. This is a great opportunity to build trust and confidence and enhance your relationship with your dog. You'll also meet other people who are crazy about their dogs too!

Conformation - (For dogs 6+ months) - 6 weeks - \$53.00

Get individual instruction on how to get the best from your dog in the conformation ring. This class is built around what each individual needs to work on rather than being a set week by week class.

Intro to Hunting/Retrieving - (For dogs 6+ months & completed Beginning Obedience) - 8 weeks - \$74.20

These classes are designed to teach the handler how to train his/her dog to become a competent hunting retriever. We start a dog with primary obedience commands, such as "come", "heel" and "whoa". With these commands, along with a couple of basic whistle and hand signals, you can effectively hunt your dog and enjoy the experience.
